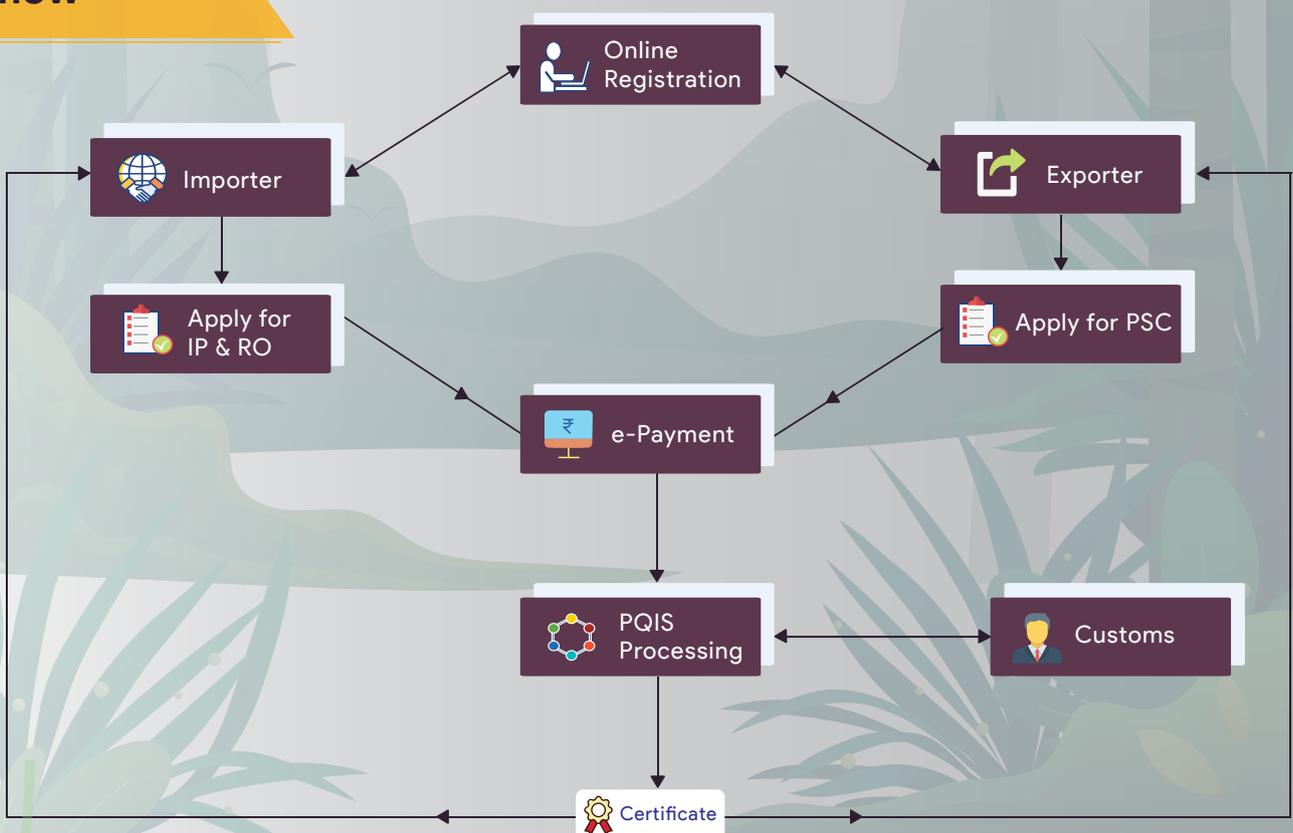
## Plant Quarantine Information System

- ✍ A workflow system to bring efficiency and effectiveness in the functioning of Plant Quarantine Stations
- ✍ Helps in speedy processing of applications for Import Permits (IP), Import Release Orders (IRO) and Phyto-Sanitary Certificates (PSC)
- ✍ Ensures availability of country and plant material specific searchable information on Import and Export procedures to PQ officers
- ✍ Makes monitoring easy at all the levels

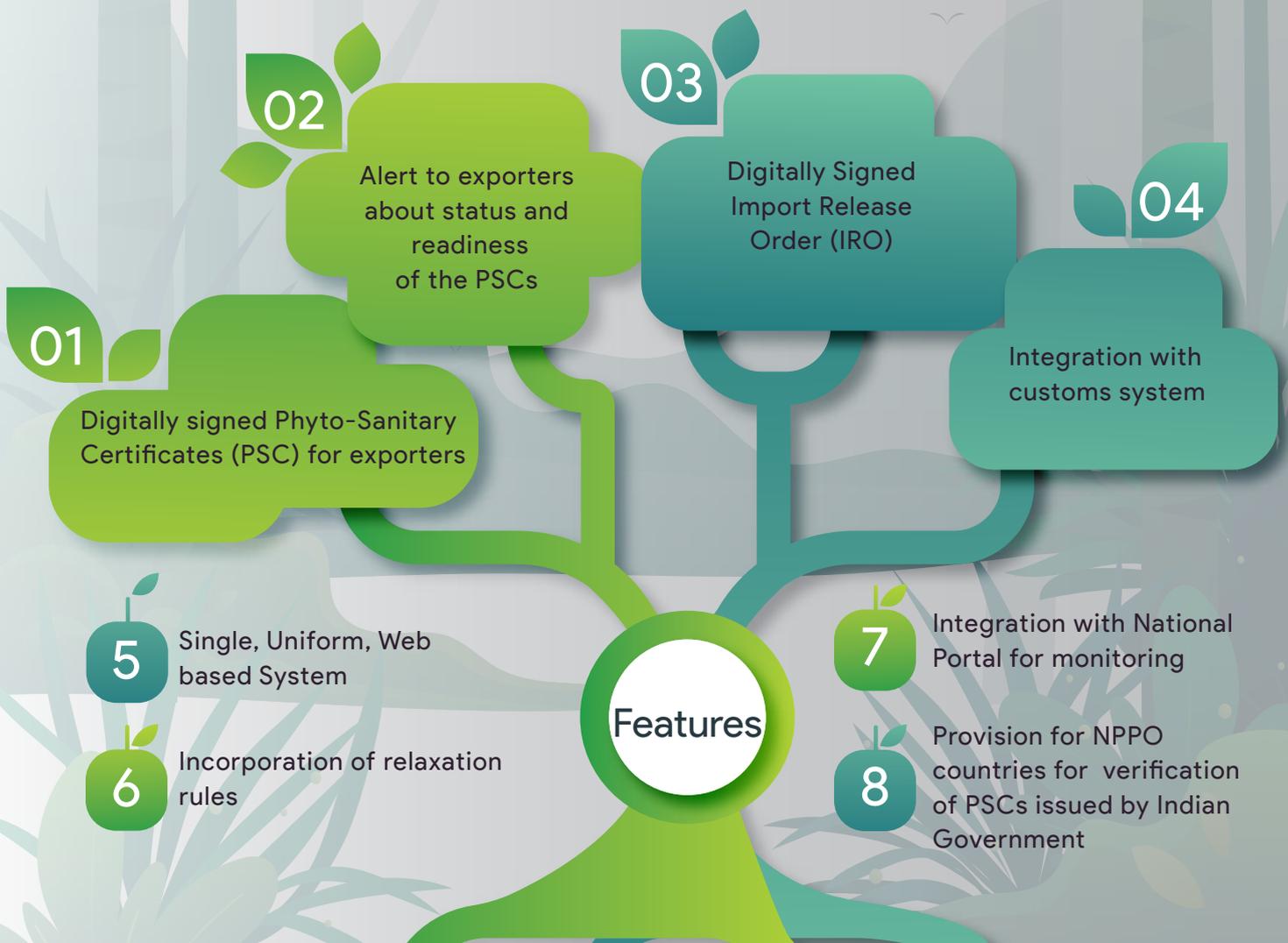
