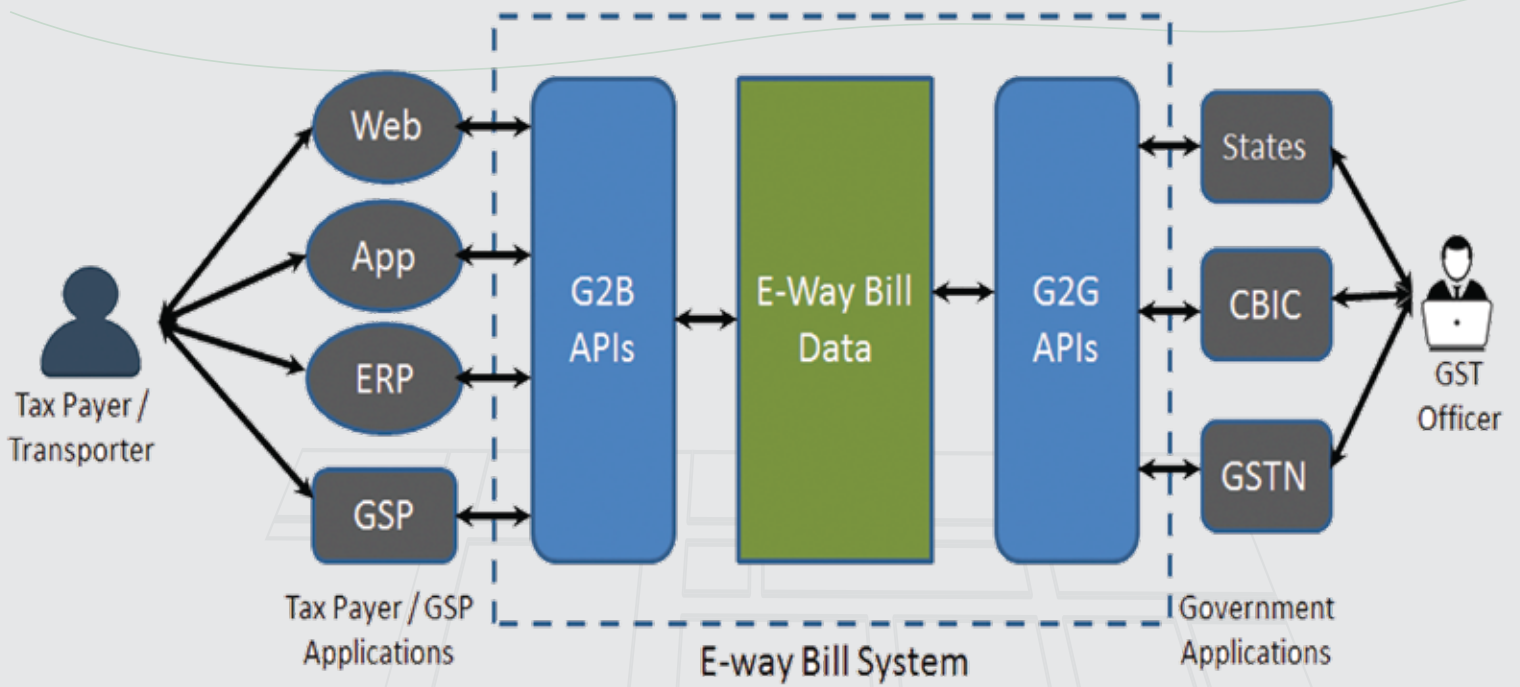

e-Way Bill provides a self-service platform to consignors, consignees and transporters to generate e-Way Bill for movement of goods from one place to another.

e-Way Bill gives details of the movement of goods carried by transporters for any consignment exceeding Rs. 50,000 and ensures transportation is done in accordance with GST laws, and tax is paid for the supply of goods. Every e-Way bill generated can be automatically used to prepare GST Return of the supplier.
